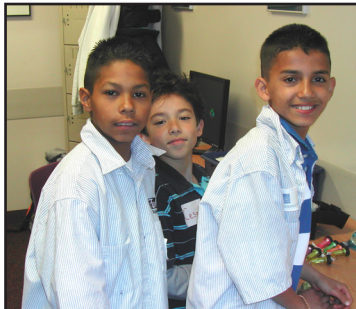
About Young Americans Center
